The Constance I. and Ralph H. Wark Collection of Early Meissen Porcelain, donated in , is one of the three finest of its type in the world, and the most significant of its kind in the United States. The collection encompasses more than works, largely tableware, produced by the Royal Saxon Porcelain Manufacture from through , with particular strength before when production diminished as a result of Prussian occupation of the city of Meissen.

The Cummer Museum holds one of the finest art collections in the Southeast, with nearly 5, objects in its Permanent Collection. The Museum offers world-class art spanning from B.C. through the 21st century, features diverse special exhibits, and is home to the Wark Collection of Early Meissen Porcelain. This book presents the Meissen porcelain collection of Ralph Henry Wark ((?)) which is situated at the Cummer Museum of Art and Gardens, Jacksonville. Donated to the Museum by Ralph H. and Constance I. Wark in , it features nearly pieces of Meissen porcelain, including rare pieces from the earliest years of the royal factory, established in /4(1). This plate is from the Smithsonian's Hans Syz Collection of Meissen Porcelain. Dr. Syz () began his collection in the early years of World War II, when he purchased eighteenth-century Meissen table wares from the Art Exchange run by the New York dealer Adolf Beckhardt ().
